
The year ahead will bring its own challenges, but I'm sure if we keep focusing on our mission and work together, we can achieve our goals and make this a great year for Breakaway.

RECIPE OF THE MONTH

Ginger bread men

Thank you to Brook Bovel for the Ginger Bread Men recipe. We were lucky enough to try her backed goods over the Christmas period.

Ingredients:

125g soft butter
2/3 cup golden syrup
1/4 cup brown sugar
3 eggs
1/2 tsp bicarb soda
1 tsp ginger and cinnamon
2 1/2 cups of plain flour

Method:


- 1. Combine all ingredients in a bowl to make a dough
- 2. Cut the dough into 4 pieces and wrap it separately
- 3. Place the dough in the fridge for 10 min until its hard (this will make the dough easy to work with)
- Preheat the oven to 150 degrees
- 5. Between 2 pieces of baking paper, roll out your dough with a rolling pin
- 6. Use cookie cutters to cut out the shapes and remove the excess dough
- 7. Place it in biscuit trays
- 8. Bake the cookies for 10-15 minutes

You can also cling wrap and freeze the dough for another day.

Icing ingredients

2 egg whites 2 cups icing sugar vanilla essence food dye


UNDER THE SPOTLIGHT LANDRI VAN DER WESTHUIZEN
