Not servicing an air conditioner or cleaning filters can lead to spread of airborne viruses and bacteria, including common cold, sore throat and tonsillitis\*

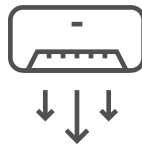

Vacuuming return air ducts and dust covers in air conditioners ensures better air flow and can save you up to 10% on your next energy bill§

An air conditioner may lose up to 5% of its efficiency each year if not properly serviced‡

1.9 million Australians leave their air conditioners on when they aren't home.

This equates to \$97 million over the 3-month summer period†

Depending on the climate zone, heating and/or cooling can account for 20% to 50% of energy used in Australian homes||

One of the best times to service your air conditioner is Spring. Spring has lower rush times for appointments and this provides ample time to check your unit before the hotter season rolls around. #
