All competitions shall be conducted under E.A. Rules and performance cards may be checked by an E.A. Steward.

EXHIBITOR PASSES: All exhibitors will need to purchase an Exhibitor Pass to enter the grounds. These are to be ordered and paid for when entering classes on Global. Cost is \$15 each. You will collect these on arrival at the Showgrounds at the horse entry gate. If not purchased online then full gate ticket prices will apply when entering the Showgrounds. Limits apply 1-5 animals up to 2 passes 4 and over up to 4 passes.

AMBULANCE AND ADMIN: THERE IS NO ADMIN, GROUND OR AMBULANCE FEE

CAMPING

- Parking and camping in designated areas is available throughout the horse section. **\$35.00 PER NIGHT PER SITE WILL BE CHARGED FOR SITES.** This must be indicated on the entry form and payment made at the time of entry. Toilets and showers are in close proximity to the Indoor Arena, the marshalling yards at the rear of The Homestead and in the center of the cattle pavilion. Toilets are also located at the rear of the M and S Centre Building .
- **A PERMIT WILL BE ISSUED AND MUST BE KEPT ON THE DRIVERS SIDE OF THE DASH.**
- **Please complete your online entries carefully & double check when booking Camping & Stabling.**
- **If not booked with your online entries by closing date the Camping and Stabling late fee will be \$45.00 per night per Stabling and Camping.**

STABLING

- **Due to Bio-Security Restrictions - NO horses will be admitted to the Toowoomba Showgrounds prior to 8:00 am on Tuesday 16th April 2024.**
- **WHEN BOOKING STABLING A \$50 REFUNDABLE MUST BE PAID OTHERWISE STABLING WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED**
- Stables will be available in the M and S Centre and surrounds. Stables are limited and not assured. While every endeavour will be made to accommodate the horses in stables preference will be given to horses traveling the furthest distance.
- **Horses domiciled in a 40 km radius of the Toowoomba Showgrounds are not likely be allocated overnight stables.**
- Stables are to be used for the stabling of horses only. No Exhibitor has any right to use or occupy any stable for any other purpose, such as accommodation, storage of fodder, bedding or tack. Any Exhibitor acting in breach of this Regulation will be fined a Penalty of \$200 for each stable per day and may, at the discretion of the Committee, be disqualified from competing at the then current Show, in which event any Award that the Exhibitor may have won at that Show is also forfeited.
- Exhibitors must provide their own feed bins and water buckets for horses stabled on the Showground.
- Stables are at a cost of \$35.00 per stable per night. A day is defined as 4:00 pm to 4:00 pm.

Please complete your online bookings carefully & double check. If not booked by closing date of TUESDAY 5th March 2024 any Camping and Stabling late fee will be \$40.00 per night

SCRATCHINGS/REFUNDS

Refunds will only be paid on the following basis – **In writing with a vet or medical certificate received no later than Monday 15th April 2024.**

No refunds allowed after the 15th April 2024

- A 20% administration fee will be deducted from entries, stabling & camping. No refund gate entry

SUBSTITUTIONS

- Application may be made to the Show Executive by the owner or his agent for permission to make a substitution entry, provided the animal to be substituted belongs to the same owner or lessee who made the original entry and every such application shall be considered by the Show Executive on its merits. If the Show Executive approves the substitution, notice must be given to the Judges of the competition not less than 15 minutes before the Competition is due to start.
- Multiple or duplicated substitution is not allowed. Substitution must be one horse/pony for another horse/pony and shall be effective for all subsequent competitions on that day of the Show. A substitution once made cannot be changed, varied or revoked that day. It is the responsibility of the Competitor to make sure that the Judge and collecting Ring Steward has been notified of the substitution before he/she starts his/her round.

CLASS CHANGES/UPGRADINGS occurring after the time of entry must be approved by David Finch or Tracey Sexton. Any entry fee variances are to be paid in cash on the day. There will be no refunds.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

EA National Jumping Rules apply unless otherwise stated.

JUNIOR RULE APPLIES for THURSDAY 18th & FRIDAY 19th APRIL

- **Horses competing in Junior Class are not eligible for any other classes.**
- **Junior horses cannot complete in open classes for Friday and Saturday.**
- **Two starts only - per horse per day.**
- **One Championships class per horse for the entire Show.**
- **HORSES MAY COMPETE IN EITHER THE MINI PRIX OR GRAND PRIX, NOT BOTH**

All horses to be registered with the Equestrian Australia for classes 105cm in height and above.

All riders competing in classes 105cm in height and above must be members of EA/EQ

All riders competing in classes 100cm and below must be members of Darling Downs Show Jumping Club or Toowoomba Jump Club or EA/EQ

AMATEUR CLASS COMPETITORS

- Must have not competed in an Olympic Games or World Equestrian Games in either Jumping or Eventing
- In the past 10 years must not have competed in a World Cup for Jumping Riders qualifying round.
- Must not have competed in section 1 and 2 at a Royal Show in Sydney, Brisbane, Melbourne, Adelaide or Perth in the past two years
- Must never have competed in a 4* 3 Day Event.
- Amateur Riders may not compete in an Amateur class if they compete in a class higher than 1.20m at that show.
- Amateur Riders may not compete in an Amateur class on a horse that will compete in any class higher than 1.20m at that show.
- Athletes must meet the membership requirements as set out in the EA

General Regulations.

1. Riders may compete as amateurs from the beginning of the calendar year in which they turn 21 years of age.
2. Organisers may at their discretion limit the number of horses a rider can start.
3. The first obstacle in the first round should be 10cm lower than the advertised starting height of the competition.
4. There will be a maximum height rise of 10cm for the jump-off
