On behalf of the board of the Royal Agricultural Society of Queensland, I would like to thank you for your support of the Heritage Bank Toowoomba Royal Show. It is only through the support of organisations such as yours that we can continue to stage Queensland's oldest and longest running community event. In fact, this year we will mark the 160th Anniversary of the Society.

Preparations are progressing well with a fair bit of interest for space from both existing and new site holders. At this stage we are 70% full with only about 10 sites left in the main pavilion.

This year's entertainment is headlined by multiple ARIA nominated country music star Adam Harvey who will be performing each evening in the Main Arena. Costa from Gardening Australia and Paul West from River Cottage Australia are returning again highlighting the importance of promoting agricultural excellence.

We will be promoting the main drive between the Glenvale Room and Founders Pavilion as a food destination with festoon lighting and more seating. We may also include live entertainment in this precinct.

Due to Workplace Health & Safety concerns we will be severely limiting the number of vehicles permitted within the grounds. As such if you do not need to deliver product to your site you must park your car in the designated car park near the main gate. A shuttle service will operate. If you must bring your vehicle in you will be issued with a permit which you must display which will include your contact details. Your vehicle must be removed from the grounds prior to 9am.

Your invoice for your site will be sent in the next few weeks. Please ensure your final balance is paid by the 13th March. Tickets will be available for collection when you arrive.
